Moses wrote the book of Genesis under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit of God. This book introduces us to the patriarchs of the Jews, Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, and Joseph. But more importantly, this book introduces us to our living, personal, eternal and loving God of all the universe. Genesis is a book of beginnings, of the earth and universe, of man, of sin, of civilization, of the nations, and of Israel.
